1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Queensland Competition Authority Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2008*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2008.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Queensland Competition Authority Regulation 2007*.

4 Insertion of new s 2A

After section 2—

insert—

‘2A Declaration of monopoly business activity—Act, s 20

‘For section 20(1) of the Act, the government business activity of providing water and sewerage services by each of the following is declared to be a monopoly business activity—

- (a) Brisbane City Council;
- (b) Bundaberg Regional Council;
- (c) Cairns Regional Council;
- (d) Gold Coast City Council;
- (e) Ipswich City Council;
- (f) Lockyer Valley Regional Council;
- (g) Logan City Council;
- (h) Mackay Regional Council;
- (i) Moreton Bay Regional Council;
- (j) Rockhampton Regional Council;
- (k) Redland City Council;
- (l) Scenic Rim Regional Council;

- (m) Somerset Regional Council;
- (n) Sunshine Coast Regional Council;
- (o) Toowoomba City Council;
- (p) Townsville City Council.’.
