Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Environmental Protection Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 3) 2008*.

3 Amendment of sch 1A (Prescribed criteria for section 151 of the Act)

- (1) Schedule 1A, part 1, section 1(a)(v) to (vii)—
renumber as section 1(a)(vi) to (viii).
- (2) Schedule 1A, part 1, section 1(a)—
insert—
‘(v) a national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land);’.

Part 3 Amendment of Nature Conservation (Administration) Regulation 2006

4 Regulation amended in pt 3

This part amends the *Nature Conservation (Administration) Regulation 2006*.

5 Amendment of s 25 (Considering application)

- (1) Section 25(1)(i) and (j)—
renumber as section 25(1)(j) and (k).
- (2) Section 25(1)—
insert—
 - ‘(i) for an application for a relevant authority for a national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land)—the indigenous management agreement for the protected area;’.

6 Insertion of new s 31A

After section 31—

insert—

‘31A Restriction on granting relevant authority for national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land)

‘The chief executive can not grant a relevant authority to a person for a national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land) without the written consent of the land trust for the protected area if, under the indigenous management agreement for the area, the consent of the land trust is required for the grant of the authority.’.
