1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Transport Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation (No. 1) 2008*.

2 Postponed commencement of particular uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2) of the postponed law is extended to the end of 25 October 2010.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the following provisions of the *Transport Legislation Amendment Act 2007*—

- sections 19 and 20
- section 26
- section 29, to the extent it inserts sections 87B to 87D
- section 31
- section 32(2), to the extent it inserts the definitions *electronic booking system*, *peak demand management plan*, *peak demand taxi*, *peak demand taxi permit* and *peak patronage period*
- section 32(3).

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 26 October 2010.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 27 October 2010.
