1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Pest Management Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2009*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Pest Management Regulation 2003*.

3 Insertion of new s 3F

After section 3E—

insert—

‘3F Exemption for homeguard precision termite management products—Act, s 10

‘(1) An exempted pest management activity carried out by an accredited installer is exempted from section 11 and part 2, division 12 of the Act.

‘(2) In this section—

accredited installer means a person who is accredited by FMC to install a homeguard precision termite management product.

exempted pest management activity means a pest management activity involving the installation of a homeguard precision termite management product.

FMC means FMC Australasia Pty Ltd ACN 095 326 891.

homeguard precision termite management product means a product manufactured by FMC that is—

- (a) made from plastic polymer sheets or granules; and
- (b) impregnated with bifenthrin at a concentration of not more than 0.1% bifenthrin.’.

4 Amendment of s 6 (Notice of change in circumstances—Act, s 54)

Section 6—

insert—

- ‘(f) a change in the technician’s physical or mental capacity that the technician knows, or ought reasonably to know, may adversely affect the technician’s ability to competently and safely carry out a pest management activity.’.

5 Amendment of s 9 (Disposal of containers)

Section 9(b)—

omit, insert—

- ‘(b) for a container that has been used for a fumigant—securely sealing the container and returning it to the person who supplied the fumigant to the pest management technician; or’.
