# Nature Conservation (Wildlife) Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2009

## Subordinate Legislation 2009 No. 264

made under the

*Nature Conservation Act 1992*

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## 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation (Wildlife) Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2009*.

## 2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Nature Conservation (Wildlife) Regulation 2006*.
