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## **Part 1 Preliminary**

### **1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Health Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 3) 2009*.

## 5 Amendment of sch 3 (Dictionary)

- (1) Schedule 3—

*insert—*

*‘registered nurse* means a registered nurse under the *Nursing Act 1992*.

*triage category 1 patient* means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse immediately on arrival at a hospital.

*triage category 2 patient* means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 10 minutes after arrival at a hospital.

*triage category 3 patient* means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 30 minutes after arrival at a hospital.

*triage category 4 patient* means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 1 hour after arrival at a hospital.

*triage category 5 patient* means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 2 hours after arrival at a hospital.’
