1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Health Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 3) 2009*.

‘registered nurse means a registered nurse under the *Nursing Act 1992*.

triage category 1 patient means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse immediately on arrival at a hospital.

triage category 2 patient means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 10 minutes after arrival at a hospital.

triage category 3 patient means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 30 minutes after arrival at a hospital.

triage category 4 patient means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 1 hour after arrival at a hospital.

triage category 5 patient means a patient who is attended to by a doctor or registered nurse within 2 hours after arrival at a hospital.’.
