## **Part 1 Preliminary**

### **1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Sugar Industry Regulation 2010*.

### **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on 1 September 2010.

## **Part 2 Authorisations for competition legislation**

### **3 Collective contracts—Act, s 237**

- (1) For section 237 of the Act, definition *region*, each part of the State consisting of the local government areas mentioned in the schedule is prescribed.

*Note—*

The local government areas of Burdekin, Cassowary Coast, Hinchinbrook and Whitsunday are in more than 1 region.

- (2) In this section—

*local government area* means a local government area under the *Local Government Act 2009*.

The Sugar Industry Regulation 1999, SL No. 339 is repealed.
