**1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Weapons Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2010*.

**2 Regulation amended**

This regulation amends the *Weapons Regulation 1996*.

**3 Amendment of s 2A (Definitions)**

Section 2A, ‘Act’—

‘An application for a licence, or renewal of a licence, may be made only—

- (a) at a police station or police establishment; or
- (b) in a way published on the QPS website including, for example, by submitting the application online.’.

**5 Omission of s 8 (Licence must be signed immediately after receipt)**

Section 8—

**6 Replacement of s 55 (Where to apply for permit to acquire)**

Section 55—

**‘55 Applying for permit to acquire**

‘An application for a permit to acquire may be made only—

- (a) at a police station or police establishment; or
- (b) in a way published on the QPS website including, for example, by submitting the application online.’.

**7 Amendment of sch 3 (Dictionary)**

Schedule 3—

*insert—*

‘***QPS website*** means the website used by the commissioner to provide public access to information about matters relating to this regulation.
