1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *State Development and Public Works Organisation (State Development Areas) Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2012*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 30 June 2012.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *State Development and Public Works Organisation (State Development Areas) Regulation 2009*.

‘(1) The parts of the State delineated in red on plan GSDA_001_012 are declared to be a State development area.

‘(2) The area is called the Gladstone State Development Area.’.

‘Part 12 Transitional provision

‘17 State is legal successor

‘(1) The State is the successor in law of the former Gladstone project board.

‘(2) In this section—

former Gladstone project board means the Gladstone Economic and Industry Development Board, which ceased to exist on 30 June 2012.’
