1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Electricity Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2012*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Electricity Regulation 2006*.

3 Insertion of new s 125A

After section 125—

insert—

‘125A Condition about prescribed statements in residential customer accounts

‘For section 55GA(5) of the Act, definition *carbon and renewable energy target cost statement*, the following statement is prescribed for an account issued by a retail entity to a residential customer during the financial year starting on 1 July 2012—

‘Qld Competition Authority estimates a 2012-13 carbon price impact on domestic tariff 11 as 2.4 c/kWh & economy tariffs 31 & 33 as 2.5 & 2.4 c/kWh—www.qca.org.au’.
