1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Civil Proceedings* (*Postponement*) *Regulation 2012*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provision

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 6 December 2013.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the *Civil Proceedings Act 2011*, part 32, division 6.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 7 December 2013.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 8 December 2013.
