  - (b) 31 December 2014 is prescribed for the 'QBuild Office Staff Certified Agreement 8 (2009)' as it applies to employees of City Parklands Transition Services Pty Ltd; and
  - (c) 31 December 2014 is prescribed for the 'South Bank Employing Office Employees' Certified Agreement 2011' as it applies to employees of City Parklands Transition Services Pty Ltd.
