1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Queensland Building and Construction Commission Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2016*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 April 2016.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Queensland Building and Construction Commission Regulation 2003*.

4 Amendment of sch 2, pt 4 (Builder—low rise licence)

Schedule 2, part 4, section 2(4)—

insert—

- (c) for building work mentioned in subsection (2A)—directly or indirectly causing the work to be carried out or providing building work services for the work if—
 - (i) a fire protection licence is required for the work; and
 - (ii) the work is—
 - (A) for Type A or Type B construction on classes 2 to 9 buildings; or
 - (B) on classes 2 to 9 buildings with a gross floor area exceeding 2000m².

5 Amendment of sch 2, pt 5 (Builder—medium rise licence)

Schedule 2, part 5, section 2(4)—

insert—

- (c) for building work mentioned in subsection (2A)—directly or indirectly causing the work to be carried out or providing building work services for the work if—
 - (i) a fire protection licence is required for the work; and
 - (ii) the work is—
 - (A) for Type A construction on classes 4 to 9 buildings; or
 - (B) to more than 3 storeys.
