1 Short title

This by-law may be cited as the *Parliamentary Service* Amendment By-law (No. 1) 2016.

2 Commencement

This by-law commences on 1 July 2016.

3 By-law amended

This by-law amends the Parliamentary Service By-law 2013.

4 Insertion of new ss 12A and 12B

After section 12-

insert—

12A Person must not smoke on parliamentary precinct

- (1) A person must not smoke on the parliamentary precinct.
- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a person in a nominated outdoor smoking place.
- (3) In this section—

nominated outdoor smoking place means a clearly designated part of the parliamentary precinct—

- (a) where smoking is not prohibited under the *Tobacco and Other Smoking Products Act* 1998; and
- (b) established by the Speaker as an area where smoking is permitted.

12B Person smoking must stop when directed

A person contravening section 12A(1) must comply with a direction given by an authorised

officer to stop the contravention.
