**1 Short title**

This declaration may be cited as the *Queen's Wharf Brisbane (Freehold Land) Declaration 2016*.

**2 Land to be granted in fee simple to the State—Act, s 43**

- (1) This is a freehold declaration for section 43(1)(a) of the Act.
- (2) The land mentioned in schedule 1, column 1 is the subject of the declaration.
- (3) Each interest mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 opposite the land is an ongoing interest for the land.
- (4) The purpose for declaring the land is stated in schedule 1, column 3 opposite the land.
