1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Domestic and Family* Violence Protection (Interstate and Foreign Orders) Amendment Regulation (No. 2) 2017.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences immediately after the commencement of the *Domestic and Family Violence Protection (Interstate and Foreign Orders) Amendment Regulation 2017.*

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Domestic and Family Violence Protection Regulation 2012.*

4 Amendment of s 4 (Declared interstate orders)

Section 4—

insert—

(h) a violence restraining order under the *Restraining Orders Act 1997* (WA) made before 1 July 2017 that addresses a domestic violence concern within the meaning of the *Domestic Violence Orders (National Recognition) Act 2017* (WA), section 9(1).

5 Amendment of s 5 (Declared registered foreign orders)

Section 5—

insert—

(g) a foreign restraining order under the *Restraining Orders Act 1997* (WA) that corresponds with an order under part 1B of that Act and that is registered under that Act.
