1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *State Penalties Enforcement Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2018*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

(1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 19 May 2019.

(2) In this section—

postponed law means the uncommenced provisions of the *State Penalties Enforcement Amendment Act 2017*.

Note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 20 May 2019.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 21 May 2019.
