#### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Liquor (Rural Hotels Concession) Amendment Regulation 2019.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2019.

## 3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the Liquor Regulation 2002.

### 4 Amendment of s 36A (Base fees for licences)

(1) Section 36A(1)(a)—

omit, insert—

- (a) either—
  - (i) for a licence other than a licence mentioned in section 202A(1) of the Act—\$3,757; or
  - (ii) for a licence mentioned in section 202A(1) of the Act—10% of the amount stated in subparagraph (i);
- (2) Section 36A(4)—

omit, insert—

- (4) For a community club licence, the base fee is—
  - (a) for a club with more than 2,000 members—\$3,061; or
  - (b) for a club with 2,000 members or less, either—
    - (i) for a licence other than a licence mentioned in section 202A(1) of the Act—\$694.60; or

(ii) for a licence mentioned in section 202A(1) of the Act—10% of the amount stated in subsection (1)(a)(i).
