- 2 Giving copies of the following documents, for each request for copies of the documents relating to a particular person—
- (a) a certificate of achievement;
 - (b) a recognition certificate under the repealed Act;
 - (c) a document (however described), of a type similar to a document mentioned in item 1 or paragraph (a) or (b), provided for by a repealed Act, other than the repealed *Vocational Education, Training and Employment Act 2000* 19.75
- 3 Giving a certificate signed by the chief executive certifying a matter relating to an apprenticeship or traineeship 19.75
