1 Short title

This notice may be cited as the Workers' Compensation and Rehabilitation (QOTE) Notice 2019.

2 Commencement

This notice commences on 30 June 2019 at the end of the day.

3 QOTE for 2019–2020 financial year—Act, s 107

- (1) For section 107(2)(a) of the Act, QOTE for the 2019–2020 financial year is \$1,574.
- (2) For section 107(2)(b) of the Act, the percentage difference in QOTE for the 2019–2020 financial year compared to QOTE for the 2018–2019 financial year is 3.02%.

4 Variation of payments for injuries—Act, s 205

For section 205(3) of the Act, the varied payment or amount, for a provision of the Act stated in column 1 of a table in schedule 1 applying to an injury sustained in the period mentioned in the table, is the payment or amount stated in column 2 opposite the provision.

5 Repeal

The Workers' Compensation and Rehabilitation (QOTE) Notice 2018, SL No. 64 is repealed.
