This part amends the *Nature Conservation (Wildlife Management) Regulation 2006.*

8 Replacement of s 261ZE (Taking protected plant under a self-assessable vegetation clearing code etc.)

Section 261ZE—

omit, insert—

261ZETaking protected plant under an accepted development vegetation clearing code

- (1) A person may take a protected plant in any area by clearing if the taking complies with the requirements applying to the area under—
 - (a) the accepted development vegetation clearing code for managing encroachment; or
 - (b) the accepted development vegetation clearing code for managing weeds.
- (2) In this section—

accepted development vegetation clearing code see the *Vegetation Management Act 1999*, section 19O(1) and (2). Nature Conservation (Wildlife) and Other Legislation Amendment Regulation 2019
