1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Natural Resources and Other Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation* 2020.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 24 May 2021.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means an uncommenced provision of the *Natural Resources and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019* stated in schedule 1.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 26 May 2021.
