Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Mining Safety and Health Legislation (Respirable Coal Dust and Silica) Amendment Regulation* 2020.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2020.

Part 2 Amendment of Coal Mining Safety and Health Regulation 2017

3 Regulation amended

This part amends the Coal Mining Safety and Health Regulation 2017.

4 Amendment of s 89 (Dust)

Section 89(1)(b)(i) and (ii)—

omit, insert—

- (i) for coal dust—1.5mg/m³ air;
- (ii) for free silica—0.05mg/m³ air.

Part 9

Transitional provision for Mining Safety and Health Legislation (Respirable Coal Dust and Silica) Amendment Regulation 2020

409 Levels of dust under s 89(1) for dust monitoring and reporting procedure

- (1) Section 89A applies as if each reference in the section to section 89(1) were a reference to section 89(1) as in force immediately before the commencement.
- (2) This section stops applying on 1 January 2021.
