1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Justice Legislation (COVID-19 Emergency Response—Documents and Oaths) Amendment Regulation (No. 2) 2021.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2021.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Justice Legislation* (COVID-19 Emergency Response—Documents and Oaths) Regulation 2020.

4 Amendment of s 5 (Special witnesses)

Section 5(3)—
omit, insert—

(3) For subsection (1)(e), a person is also a special witness for a document if the document is prepared by the public trustee and the person is a justice or commissioner for declarations who is an employee of the public trustee.

7 Amendment of s 13 (Persons who may be directed to sign)

(1) Section 13(2)(b)(i) and (ii)— *omit.*

(2) Section 13(2)(b)(iii) and (iv)—
renumber as section 13(2)(b)(i) and (ii).

8 Amendment of s 14 (Signing in physical presence requires special witness)

Section 14(2)—
omit, insert—

(2) The signing of the document by the substitute signatory must be witnessed by a special witness.

9 Amendment of s 16 (Witnesses must be or include special witness)

Section 16(1)—
omit, insert—

(1) A document may be witnessed by audio visual link only if the witness is a special witness for the document.

10 Amendment of s 20 (Action after witness confirms document)

(1) Section 20(1)—

omit, insert—

(1) After a witness confirms a document witnessed by the witness by audio visual link, the witness must give the document or a true copy of the document to the relevant person for the document.

Examples of giving a true copy of a document to a person—

scanning the document and emailing the scanned copy to the person

- giving a hard copy printout of the document to the person
- (2) Section 20(3), definition *relevant person*, paragraphs (a) and (b)—*omit*.
- (3) Section 20(3) definition *relevant person*, paragraphs (c) and (d)—

Example for subsection (5)—

The official version of a general power of attorney may be given to a bank or other entity, and relied on by the bank or other entity, as evidence of the general power of attorney.
