- (c) a document (however described), of a type similar to a document mentioned in item 1 or paragraph (a) or (b), provided for by a repealed Act, other than the repealed *Vocational Education, Training and Employment Act 2000*
- Giving a certificate signed by the chief executive certifying a matter relating to an apprenticeship or traineeship
