1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Cross River Rail Delivery Authority (Gold Coast Infill Stations Project) Amendment Regulation 2021.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the Cross River Rail Delivery Authority Regulation 2019.

3 Amendment of s 2 (Definitions)

Section 2—

insert—

active transport infrastructure see the *Transport Planning and Coordination Act 1994*, section 8A(3).

Gold Coast infill stations project means the project known as the Gold Coast infill stations project that—

- (a) involves—
 - (i) providing new railway stations on the Brisbane to Gold Coast railway line at Merrimac, Pimpama and in the northern part of Helensvale; and
 - (ii) providing or improving other rail transport infrastructure, road transport infrastructure and active transport infrastructure in relation to the stations; and
- (b) is described in the document called 'Gold Coast Infill Stations—Project Description Report' prepared by the authority and dated April 2021.
