(1) The speed limit applying to the rider of a personal mobility device is—

- (a) for a length of footpath or shared path to which a personal mobility device speed limit sign or personal mobility device speed limit road marking applies—the number of kilometres per hour indicated by the number on the sign or marking; or
- (b) for a length of footpath or shared path to which paragraph (a) does not apply—12km/h; or
- (c) for a rider riding across a road using a crossing on the road—12km/h; or
- (d) otherwise—25km/h.
- (2) Subsection (1)—
 - (a) applies to the rider of a personal mobility device despite a higher speed limit that would otherwise apply to the rider under this part; and
 - (b) does not affect another provision of this part that requires the rider of a personal mobility device to ride at a speed limit that is lower than a speed limit mentioned in subsection (1).
- (3) For subsection (1)(a), a personal mobility device speed limit sign or personal mobility device speed limit road marking applies to a length of footpath or shared path beginning at the sign or marking and ending at the nearest of the following—
 - (a) a speed limit sign or speed limit road marking on the path with a lower number on the sign or marking;
 - (b) a personal mobility device speed limit sign or personal mobility device speed limit road marking on the path with a different number on the sign or marking;
