This regulation may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation* (Fee Unit) Amendment Regulation 2023.

This regulation amends the Acts Interpretation (Fee Unit) Regulation 2022.

The value of a fee unit for an Act, other than an Act or part of an Act mentioned in schedule 1, is—

- (a) from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023—\$1.025; and
- (b) from 1 July 2023—\$1.060.

5 Replacement of s 3 (Value of fee unit for particular Acts—Act, s 48B)

3 Value of fee unit for particular Acts—Act, s 48B

(1) The value of a fee unit for an Act or a part of an Act mentioned in schedule 1, part 1 is—

- (a) from 1 July to 31 August 2023—\$1.025; and
- (b) from 1 September 2023—\$1.060.
- (2) The value of a fee unit for an Act or a part of an Act mentioned in schedule 1, part 2 is—
 - (a) from 1 July to 30 September 2023—\$1.025; and
 - (b) from 1 October 2023—\$1.060.
- (3) The value of a fee unit for an Act or a part of an Act mentioned in schedule 1, part 3 is—
 - (a) from 1 July to 31 December 2023—\$1.025; and
 - (b) from 1 January 2024—\$1.060.
- (4) The value of a fee unit for an Act or a part of an Act mentioned in schedule 1, part 4 is—
 - (a) from 1 July 2023 to 30 April 2024—\$1.025; and
 - (b) from 1 May 2024—\$1.060.
