1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Industrial Relations and* Other Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2023.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 3 November 2024.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the uncommenced provisions of the *Industrial Relations and Other Legislation Amendment Act* 2022.

Note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 4 November 2024.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 5 November 2024.
