1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *National Energy Retail Law (Queensland) Amendment Regulation 2023.*

- (1A) Subrule (1B) applies in relation to a bill issued during the financial year starting 1 July 2023 to a residential customer in Queensland for the sale or supply of electricity.
- (1B) The retailer must use its best endeavours to include the following statement at the beginning of the bill—
 - 'The Queensland Government is providing a cost of living rebate to your household. The Australian Government is contributing funds for customers eligible under the Energy Price Relief Plan.'.
- (2) This section expires on 1 July 2024.
