1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation Legislation Amendment Regulation 2024*.

For the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*, section 70E(3), the purpose of the revocation of the dedication of a forest reserve under section 4 is to allow the forest reserve to become a protected area.
