1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Supreme Court of Queensland Regulation 2025*.

2 Districts—Act, s 57

- (1) Each district mentioned in schedule 1, column 1 is continued as a Supreme Court district.

Note—

The districts were established under the repealed *Supreme Court Regulation 1998*, section 3(1).

- (2) Each Supreme Court district consists of the Magistrates Court district or districts mentioned in schedule 1, column 2 opposite the Supreme Court district.

3 Repeal

The Supreme Court of Queensland Regulation 2012, SL No. 149 is repealed.
