Erratum to Explanatory Notes

Title of the Bill

The Carers (Recognition) Amendment Bill 2010

Reasons for Erratum

To clarify the policy intent of the Bill and to provide an example of the effect of one of the new principles inserted by the Bill in the Queensland Carers Charter.

Notes on Provisions

1. Clause 5, pages 3-4, first sentence.

After the first sentence, insert the following sentence, “The words ‘decisionmaker’ include both day to day decision-maker where the lawful guardian of the child is someone other than the grandparent and also where the grandparent is the lawful guardian of the child”.

2. Clause 9, page 4, last sentence.

After the last sentence, insert the following sentence, “An example of the application of the new principle 11 is Grandparents providing full-time care for their grandchildren could access information of a general nature that could be made publicly available, for example, the availability of respite services. The principle is not intended to override obligations created under other Acts such as the *Information Privacy Act 2009*”.
