#### Acceptance of offer

*Clause***13.(1)** If a claimant wishes to accept the amount offered by the chief executive, the claimant must notify the chief executive, in the form approved by the chief executive, of the acceptance within 28 days of receiving the offer.

(2) The chief executive must authorise the Public Trustee to pay the amount to the claimant as quickly as possible after being notified of the acceptance of the offer.

(3) The chief executive may extend the period of 28 days mentioned in subsection (1) if, in a particular case, the chief executive considers the circumstances warrant an extension of the period.

(4) A claimant is not entitled to payment from the fund if the claimant

specified in this section or, if an extended period is allowed, the extended

#### **Payment by Public Trustee**

Clause 14. On receiving written authorisation from the chief executive to pay17an amount to a claimant, the Public Trustee must pay the amount to the18claimant.19

#### Possible balance in fund

*Clause***15.(1)** If—

- (a) some of the claimants do not accept the amount offered by the 22 chief executive; or 23
- (b) interest accrues to the fund in addition to that taken into account under section 12(1)(b);

the amount to which claimants are entitled is not affected.

(2) Any balance left in the fund must be refunded to the contributors to 27 the fund in the same proportions that they contributed to it. 28
