An Act to amend and repeal certain Acts in relation to the appointment of Supreme Court Judges, and for other purposes

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.
