Objectives of the Amendments

A minor and technical amendment is required as a result of changes to relevant legislation.

Achievement of the Objectives

The objectives will be achieved by making an amendment to the Schedule 2 Dictionary to omit from complaints entity, the Health Quality and Complaints Commission under the *Health Quality and Complaints Commission Act 2006*, and to insert the Health Ombudsman. This minor technical amendment is required as the Health Quality and Complaints Commission will cease at the end of June 2013.
