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## **NATURE CONSERVATION (PROTECTED AREAS) REGULATION 1994**

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 1 June 1995]

### **Short title**

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation (Protected Areas) Regulation 1994*.

### **Definitions**

2. In this regulation—

“**forestry chief executive**” means the chief executive of the department that deals with matters arising under the *Forestry Act 1959*.

“**mining chief executive**” means the chief executive of the department that deals with matters arising under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*.

### **Dedication and naming of national parks (scientific)**

3. Each of the areas of Crown land described in schedule 1, column 2 is—

- (a) dedicated as a national park (scientific); and
- (b) assigned the name set opposite it in the schedule, column 1.

### **Dedication and naming of national parks**

4. Each of the areas of Crown land described in schedule 2, column 2 is—

- (a) dedicated as a national park; and
- (b) assigned the name set opposite it in the schedule, column 1.

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**Dedication and naming of conservation parks**

5. Each of the areas of Crown land described in schedule 3, column 2 is—

- (a) dedicated as a conservation park; and
- (b) assigned the name set opposite it in the schedule, column 1.

**Dedication, naming and trustees of resources reserves**

6. Each of the areas of Crown land described in schedule 4, column 2 is—

- (a) dedicated as a resources reserve; and
- (b) assigned the name set out opposite it in the schedule, column 1; and
- (c) in the cases specified—placed under the management of the trustees set opposite it in the schedule, column 3.

**Declaration and naming of nature refuges**

7. Each of the areas of land described in schedule 5 is—

- (a) declared a nature refuge; and
- (b) assigned the name specified in the schedule.

**Declared management intent**

8.(1) The declared management intent for a nature refuge is specified in schedule 5.

(2) Subsection (1) has effect subject to the Act, section 22 (Management principles of Nature Refuges).

**Duration**

9. The duration of each part of schedule 5 is specified in the schedule.

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**Reference to plan**

**10.** In the description of an area in schedules 1 to 5, a reference to a plan, the number of which uses—

- (a) the prefix ‘NPW’ or ‘PA’—is a reference to a plan held by and available for inspection in the department; and
- (b) the prefix ‘FTY’—is a reference to a plan held by and available for inspection in the department that deals with matters arising under the *Forestry Act 1959*; and
- (c) any other prefix— is a reference to a plan held by and available for inspection in the department that deals with matters arising under the *Land Act 1962*.

##### **Name of area**

1. Berlin Scrub Nature Refuge.

##### **Description**

2. The part of lot 1 on plan RP 67404 situated in the County of Churchill, containing an area of about 41.9 ha, shown hachured on plan PA1<sup>1</sup>.

##### **Significant cultural and natural resources and values**

7. Berlin Scrub Nature Refuge is comprised mostly of sediments (sandstones of the marburg formation) supporting—

- (a) well developed tall softwood scrub and brigalow-softwood communities; and
- (b) significant wildlife, including—
  - (i) the rare plant brown sarcochilus (*Sarcochilus dilatatus*), the vulnerable plant Lloyd's mock olive (*Notelaea lloydii*) and *Hibiscus sturtii*; and
  - (ii) the regent bowerbird (*Sericulus chrysocephalus*); and
- (c) habitat for the vulnerable black-breasted button quail (*Turnix melanogaster*).

SCHEDULE 5 (continued)

**Proposed management intent and use**

**8.** The nature refuge will be managed, under the conservation agreement between the land-holder and the Minister, specifically—

- (a) to maintain and foster wildlife populations and communities; and
- (b) for educational purposes; and
- (c) to provide for—
  - (i) the gathering of firewood for the land-holder's personal use; and
  - (ii) controlled grazing of domestic animals by the land-holder; and
  - (iii) the construction, maintenance and use of minimal disturbance walking tracks.

**Duration**

**9.** The duration of the declaration of the nature refuge is the duration of the conservation agreement mentioned in section 4.<sup>2</sup>
