1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Health and Hospitals Network Regulation 2012*.

2 Definitions

In this regulation—

Australian Standard Geographical Classification means the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (Cat. No. 1216.0), July 2011 edition published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

Australian Statistical Geography Standard means the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (Cat. No. 1270.0.55.001), July 2011 edition published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

community of Cardwell means the area consisting of statistical area level 1 (SA1) 3116116, 3116117, 3116118, 3116119, 3116106, 3116123, 3116122, 3116139.

community of Taroom means the area consisting of statistical area level 1 (SA1) 3119410, 3119407, 3119408.

community of Urandangi means the area consisting of mesh blocks 30023480000 and 30023490000.

local government area means a local government area under the Australian Standard Geographical Classification.

mesh block means a mesh block under the Australian Statistical Geography Standard.

statistical area level 1 (SA1) means a statistical area level 1 (SA1) under the Australian Statistical Geography Standard.

statistical local area means a statistical local area under the Australian Standard Geographical Classification.

3 Establishment of Local Health and Hospital Networks—Act, s 17

- (1) A part of the State, a public sector hospital, public sector health service facility or public sector health service mentioned in the schedule, column 2 is declared to be a network area for a Local Health and Hospital Network.
- (2) A Local Health and Hospital Network mentioned in the schedule, column 1 opposite a network area is established as the network for the network area.
- (3) The name mentioned in the schedule, column 1 opposite the network area is the name assigned to the network.
