1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Integrity Regulation 2011*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 January 2012.

3 Entities prescribed for meaning of *public sector officer*—Act, s 47

The following are entities prescribed for the Act, section 47(h)—

- (a) the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games Corporation; and
- (b) each Hospital and Health Service established under the *Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011*, section 7.
