1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Regulation 2011*.

2 Prescribed dams for submitting flood mitigation manuals and flood event reports—Act, s 371A

For section 371A(1) of the Act, each of the following dams is prescribed—

- (a) North Pine Dam;
- (b) Somerset Dam;
- (c) Wivenhoe Dam.
