Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Gold Coast Waterways Authority Regulation 2012*.

Part 2 Marina owner levy

2 Marina owner levy—Act, s 42

- (1) The annual levy payable by the owner of a marina under section 42 of the Act is the total of the amounts payable for each berth at the marina worked out under subsection (2).
- (2) For subsection (1), the amount payable for each berth is as follows—
 - (a) if the berth is not more than 12m in length—\$192.65;
 - (b) if the berth is more than 12m but not more than 18m in length—\$205.50;
 - (c) if the berth is more than 18m in length—\$229.95.
- (3) A reference in subsection (2) to the length of a berth is a reference to its length as at 31 December immediately before the levy is to be paid.
