# Commonwealth Games Arrangements Regulation 2013

## Part 1 Preliminary

#### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Commonwealth Games Arrangements Regulation 2013*.

# Part 1A Winding-up of corporation

#### 1A Dissolution day—Act, s 46

For section 46(1) of the Act, the dissolution day is 31 December 2018.

# Part 2 Protected images and protected references

### 2 ACGA images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *ACGA image*, paragraph (a), each image in schedule 1 is an ACGA image.

### 3 CGF images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *CGF image*, paragraph (a), each image in schedule 2 is a CGF image.

### 4 Games images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *Games image*, paragraph (a), the following are Games images—

- (a) each image in schedule 3;
- (b) a substantial part of an image mentioned in paragraph (a), including, for example, the stylised representation of the phrase 'Gold Coast 2018', as it appears in the images shown in schedule 3, items 1 to 3.

#### 5 Games references

- (1) For the Act, schedule 4, definition *Games reference*, paragraph (c), each expression mentioned in schedule 4 is a Games reference.
- (2) For the Act, section 53(2), definition *generic Games reference*, paragraph (b), a Games reference under subsection (1) is a generic Games reference.

#### 6 ACGA references

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *ACGA reference*, paragraph (b), each expression mentioned in schedule 5 is an ACGA reference.

# Part 3 Relevant places for police seizure powers

### 7 Relevant places for police seizure powers—Act, s 66

- (1) For section 66(3) of the Act, each of the places stated in schedule 6, column 1 is a relevant place for the period stated opposite in column 2.
- (2) A reference in schedule 6, column 2 to a period from a stated day (the *first day*) to a stated day (the *last day*) is a reference to a period from the beginning of the first day to the end of the last day.

## 8 Expiry of part and sch 6

This part and schedule 6 expire on 31 December 2018.







