# Supreme Court of Queensland Regulation 2012

## 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Supreme Court of Queensland Regulation 2012*.

## 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2012.

## 3 Districts—Act, s 57

- (1) Each district mentioned in the schedule, column 1 is continued as a Supreme Court district.

*Note—*

The districts were established under the repealed *Supreme Court Regulation 1998*, section 3(1).

- (2) Each Supreme Court district consists of the Magistrates Court district or districts mentioned in the schedule, column 2 opposite the Supreme Court district.
