# Major Events (Motor Racing Events) Regulation 2015

## Part 1 Preliminary

### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Major Events (Motor Racing Events) Regulation 2015*.

### 2 Definitions

In this regulation—

*Gold Coast 500* means the major event prescribed under section 9.

*motor racing event* means—

- (a) the Gold Coast 500; or
- (b) the Townsville 500.

*Townsville 500* means the major event prescribed under section 3.

## Part 2 Townsville 500

### 3 Townsville 500 is a major event—Act, s 12

For section 12(1) of the Act, the V8 Supercars motor racing event known as the Townsville 500 to be held in 2023 is prescribed as a major event.

### 4 Major event organiser for Townsville 500—Act, s 12

For section 12(2)(a) of the Act, V8 Supercars Australia Pty Ltd ACN 077 053 484 is prescribed as the major event organiser for the Townsville 500.

**5 Major event area for Townsville 500—Act, s 12**

For section 12(2)(b) of the Act, the major event area prescribed for the Townsville 500 is the area surrounding the Townsville Civic Theatre shown on the map in schedule 1 as the major event area.

**6 Major event period for Townsville 500—Act, s 12**

For section 12(2)(c) of the Act, the major event period for the Townsville 500 is the period from midday on 6 July 2023 to midday on 10 July 2023.

**7 Carrying out temporary works for Townsville 500—Act, s 16**

For section 16(2) of the Act, the following periods are prescribed—

- (a) from the beginning of the day on 12 June 2023 to midday on 6 July 2023;
- (b) from midday on 10 July 2023 to midnight on 22 July 2023.

**8 Declaration of official title for Townsville 500—Act, s 51**

For section 51(1)(b) of the Act, the title ‘2023 NTI Townsville 500’ is declared an official title for the Townsville 500.

## **Part 3 Gold Coast 500**

**9 Gold Coast 500 is a major event—Act, s 12**

For section 12(1) of the Act, the V8 Supercars motor racing event known as the Gold Coast 500 to be held in 2022 is prescribed as a major event.

**10 Major event organiser for Gold Coast 500—Act, s 12**

For section 12(2)(a) of the Act, V8 Supercars Australia Pty Ltd ACN 077 053 484 is prescribed as the major event organiser for the Gold Coast 500.

**11 Major event area for Gold Coast 500—Act, s 12**

For section 12(2)(b) of the Act, the major event area prescribed for the Gold Coast 500 is the area consisting of the following areas, shown on the map in schedule 2 as the major event area—

- (a) the areas surrounding Macintosh Island Park in Surfers Paradise;
- (b) the areas in the Southport Broadwater Parklands;
- (c) 3332 Surfers Paradise Boulevard, Surfers Paradise.

**12 Major event period for Gold Coast 500—Act, s 12**

For section 12(2)(c) of the Act, the major event period for the Gold Coast 500 is the period from midday on 27 October 2022 to midday on 31 October 2022.

**13 Carrying out temporary works for Gold Coast 500—Act, s 16**

For section 16(2) of the Act, the following periods are prescribed—

- (a) from the beginning of the day on 19 September 2022 to midday on 27 October 2022;
- (b) from midday on 31 October 2022 to midnight on 19 November 2022.

**14 Declaration of official title for Gold Coast 500—Act, s 51**

For section 51(1)(b) of the Act, the title ‘2022 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500’ is declared an official title for the Gold Coast 500.

**Part 4 Provisions about motor racing events**

**15 Application of Act provisions to motor racing events**

For sections 17 and 55 of the Act, the following provisions of the Act are prescribed, under section 12(2)(d) of the Act, to apply to a motor racing event and the major event area for the major event period—

- (a) sections 18(1) to (4), (6), (7) and (9), 19 to 28, 31, 36 and 40;
- (b) part 6.

**16 Display of poster prescribed prohibited conduct**

- (1) For section 20(6)(h) of the Act, displaying a poster on a property inside the major event area for a motor racing event, including on the outside of a building or structure, is prescribed.
- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a poster displayed by a person if the poster—
  - (a) was displayed before the major event period for the motor racing event; and
  - (b) was displayed in the course of the person’s ordinary activities.

---

**17 Persons who may be appointed as authorised persons**

For section 56(1)(d) of the Act, crowd controllers under the *Security Providers Act 1993* are prescribed for a motor racing event.

**18 Limitation on particular authorised person's powers**

- (1) This section limits, for section 57(2) of the Act, the powers of particular authorised persons for a motor racing event.
- (2) The powers of an authorised person who is not a police officer do not include the powers stated in sections 25, 54, 63 and 65 of the Act.

**19 Application of laws to roads**

For section 80(1)(b) of the Act, each road shown in the major event area for a motor racing event shown on the map in schedule 1 or 2 ceases to be a road for the major event period for the event.

**20 Assessing building work**

- (1) This section applies to a building certifier engaged to assess building work for the purpose of giving a compliance certificate for section 78(3) of the Act.
- (2) Before giving a compliance certificate for the building work, the building certifier must—
  - (a) consult the Queensland Fire and Emergency Service about a special fire service or any work involving a fire-related performance solution for the building work; and
  - (b) if the building work is for a building or structure that is proposed to have a special fire service or involves a fire-related performance solution—obtain and consider a report from the Queensland Fire and Emergency Service on the suitability of the proposed special fire service or fire-related performance solution.

(3) In this section—

*building certifier* see the *Building Act 1975*, section 8.

*building work* see the *Building Act 1975*, section 5.


*fire-related performance solution* means a performance solution as defined under the *Building Act 1975*, schedule 2 for performance requirements relating to fire safety.

*performance requirements* see the *Building Act 1975*, schedule 2.

*special fire service* see the *Building Act 1975*, schedule 2.
