General outline

Short title

Professional Standards (South Australian Bar Association Inc Scheme) Notice 2011.

Authorising law

Section 14(1) of the *Professional Standards Act 2004*.

Policy objectives and the reasons for them

The primary objective of the *notice* is to give notice of the approval of an interstate scheme by the Professional Standards Council of South Australia.

Achievement of policy objectives

The notice achieves its objectives by giving notice of the approval of the South Australian Bar Association Inc Scheme by the Professional Standards Council of South Australia.

Consistency with policy objectives of authorising law
