Policy objectives and the reasons for them

The policy objective of the Proclamation is to commence the *Grammar Schools Act 2016* (the Act) on 1 January 2017.

The Act regulates the establishment and governance of grammar schools. It will replace the *Grammar Schools Act 1975* with modern legislation that meets the contemporary needs of grammar schools; reduces red tape on the schools; removes prescriptive requirements regarding financial accountability of grammar schools; and removes the ability to establish additional grammar schools in the future.

Achievement of the policy objective

The policy objective is achieved by providing for the Act to commence on 1 January 2017.

Consistency with policy objectives of authorising law

The Proclamation is consistent with the objectives of Grammar Schools Act 2016.

Inconsistency with policy objectives of other legislation

The Proclamation is consistent with the policy objectives of other legislation.

Benefits and costs of implementation

The commencement of the Act will not result in any additional costs to Government.

Consistency with fundamental legislative principles

The Proclamation is consistent with fundamental legislative principles.

Consultation

The eight Queensland grammar school boards of trustees were consulted during a review of the legislative scheme. They have been advised about the passage of the Act.
