

# Proclamation to commence stated provisions of the Electoral and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019

## Human Rights Certificate

### Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, Honourable Yvette D’Ath MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, Leader of the House, provide this human rights certificate with respect to the Proclamation to commence stated provisions of the *Electoral and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019*.

In my opinion, the Proclamation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

### Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The proclamation fixes 31 January 2020 as the day for the commencement of stated provisions of the *Electoral and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019*.

### Human Rights Issues

The Proclamation does not affect or engage a human right.

### Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise a human rights issue.
