In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Cameron Dick MP, Treasurer and Minister for Infrastructure and Planning provide this human rights certificate with respect to the Superannuation (State Public Sector) Amendment Notice (No. 2) 2020 (the Amendment Notice) made under the Superannuation (State Public Sector) Act 1990.

In my opinion, the Amendment Notice is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The purpose of the Amendment Notice is to ensure the continuation of existing QSuper membership arrangements of employees who were subject to a transfer of employment from existing units of the State public sector to new employers or to prescribe arrangements for employees of a new unit of the State public sector. Additionally, the Amendment Notice will address requests from non-core units to offer choice of fund, remove redundant entries and amend department names that have changed.

Human Rights Issues

Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The Amendment Notice does not impact a human right.

Conclusion

I consider that the Amendment Notice is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise a human rights issue.
