

# Work Health and Safety (Plant Registration) Amendment Regulation 2020

## Human Rights Certificate

### Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Grace Grace MP, Minister for Education and Minister for Industrial Relations, provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Work Health and Safety (Plant Registration) Amendment Regulation 2020* made under the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*.

In my opinion, the *Work Health and Safety (Plant Registration) Amendment Regulation 2020*, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

## Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The objectives of the *Work Health and Safety (Plant Registration) Amendment Regulation 2020* are to:

- maintain a requirement for annual renewal of plant item registration; and
- allow the regulator to waive and refund the plant item registration fee for amusement devices in the current plant registration cycle (1 February 2020 to 31 January 2021).

## Human Rights Issues

### Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The amendment regulation does not affect or engage a human right under Part 2, Division 2 and 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*.

## Conclusion

I consider that the *Work Health and Safety (Plant Registration) Amendment Regulation 2020* is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise a human rights issue.
